					Lector at mass—parent do one reading, youth do one reading. Lectors should be 6 th grade or above
					Musician—parent and youth could lead music along with a song leader
					Mass server—parent and child can serve together— Both must go through server training(coming up Sept 13 1:30 – 3 PM)
					Offertory—whole family can participate
					Rosary—parent and child—or whole family can lead together
					Care for flowerbeds around church
					Youth Ministry—plan one activity for middle school or high school youth group—volunteer along with your child for a youth activity
					Quilt or do handwork for the Ladies—embroider quilt blocks together at home
					Parish picnic—entire family including school-aged youth (4 th & above) should participate
					Prayer ministry—entire family could pledge to pray together daily for the needs of parishioners/parish
					Eucharistic Ministers – Confirmed high school aged youth and parents can participate in this ministry when approved by the Bishop
					Clean church one week
					Visit the nursing homes
					As a family, decide toys, clothes, “things” that could be donated to MCMC. Make sure they are in good condition.
