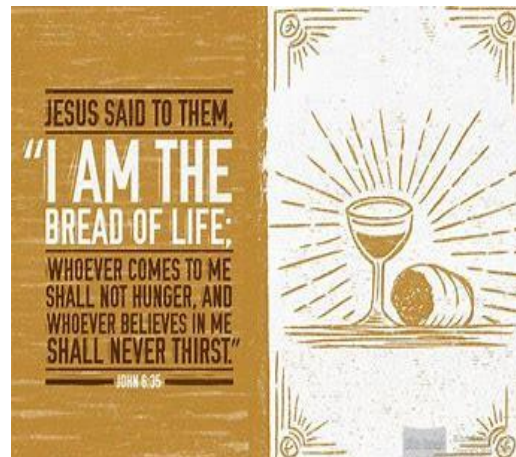

## PASTOR'S NOTES . . .

In recent days I have been asked what the Diocese of Jefferson City is doing to encourage and support vocations to the priesthood and consecrated religious life.

First, I am a member of the Diocesan Vocations Committee. Please pray for Father Christopher Aubuchon, our new Director of Vocations, as he heads up this vital ministry.

We meet regularly to brainstorm ideas to promote and support our young people as they search for their place in life. Each fall the members of the Vocation Committee schedule visits to all of our parish schools, each of us taking four or five schools to meet with students and faculty throughout the school year.

We generally meet with grades four through high school, boys and girls. We talk about our own vocational search and what we enjoy about our ministry. We share our life story, hobbies, interests and whatever comes up in our Question and Answer session. We are hoping this year to add some video segments to our presentations and other activities perhaps.

The Diocese also holds a "Sixth Grade Vocation Day" at the Cathedral, and all sixth graders are expected to attend. We have at least one priest, one married couple and a religious sister speak to the students along with music, prayer, Eucharistic Adoration and Mass.

During the summer we sponsor ChristPower, a youth service and spiritual retreat. You have likely seen pictures in the Catholic Missourian of these programs.

We also host Camp Maccabees for boys and Camp Sienna for girls each summer, for junior high students.

I have been hoping also to restart the Family Vocation Cross ministry at St. Andrew's. Can someone please help me get that back on track? Thank you.

If you have any ideas or suggestions on how we might better reach out to our young people, please feel free to contact me as your Vocation Committee representative. And, as always, we remember the command of Jesus: The harvest is great but the laborers are few, pray, therefore, to the Lord of the harvest that he would send out laborers into the harvest."
