## PASTOR'S NOTES . . .

Happy Thanksgiving to all of you! By going to Mass on Thanksgiving, you are thanking God in the best possible way. In the Gospel we just heard, Jesus underscores the importance of expressing gratitude: He praises the Samaritan who returned to thank him. He had cured ten lepers, but only one came back to say, "thank you."

We should not be too hard on the other nine. After all, they were doing what Jesus told them: "Go show yourselves to the priests." They were obeying Jesus' instructions. The Samaritan, however, obeyed a deeper law: the law of gratitude. In our hearts, you and I know the importance of gratitude. We spend time teaching our children how to say "thank you," how to write a note of appreciation. But then we adults often fail to take the time to say, "thank you." Sometimes we think, "Well, the other person knows I am grateful. Why state the obvious?" But the other person may not know so we tell them "thank you".

The Samaritan gives us a wonderful example of prompt gratitude. The person who has a grateful heart - and who expresses it in a sincere way - builds strong friendships. That applies not only on a human level, but also to our communication with God.

The power of gratitude can be seen by way of contrast. The opposite of gratitude is complaining. We complain because we are unhappy, ungrateful about our lives. Most of our complaining and criticizing does little good, but a word of gratitude can make someone's day, maybe even change their life.

This week we celebrate Thanksgiving Day. It is a beautiful holiday. Jesus shows us the importance of giving thanks in this gospel passage. "Has none but this foreigner returned to give thanks to God? Then he said to him, "Stand up and go; your faith has saved you." How will we give thanks this week and throughout the coming year?
