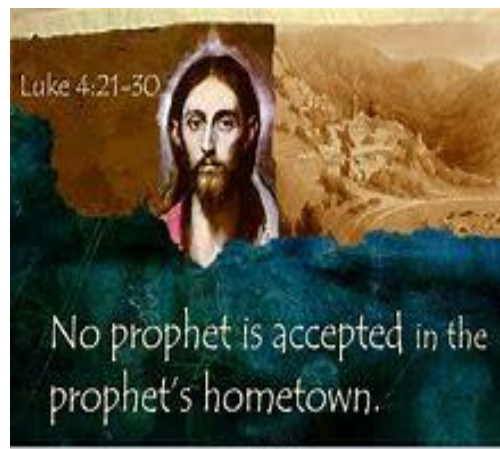

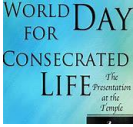
## ANNUNCIATION PARISH ACTIVITIES
