PASTOR'S NOTES . . .

"Put out into deep water and lower your nets for a catch."

"Put out into deep water and lower your nets for a catch." These words ring out for us today, and they invite us to remember the past with gratitude, to live the present with enthusiasm and to look forward to the future with confidence: "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever" (Heb 13:8). Peter and his companions trusted Christ's words, and lowered their nets once more." When they had done this, they caught a great number of fish".

The Catholic Church is reeling under a season of purification, brought on (at least in part) by the sin of some of her members, including her clergy. Our Church needs conversion at every level. As members of Christ's Body, we are called to grieve, repent and work for the healing and authentic conversion and renewal of this Church that we love. We must also be honest about the reality we face.

We are sons and daughters of the Church, worshipping in the local parish. It was Saint Cyprian who is most often quoted concerning this vital truth: "He who has turned his back on the Church of Christ shall not come to the rewards of Christ; You cannot have God for your Father if you do not have the Church for your mother. Our Lord warns us when He says: 'He that is not with Me is against Me, and he that gathers not with Me scatters'; Whosoever breaks the peace and harmony of the Church acts against Christ" (On the Unity of the Catholic Church).

Bishop McKnight has called for us, as the Church, especially in our diocese, to avoid anything that will cause division in the Body of Christ. We are called to love the Church with the affection of sons and daughters; she is our "mother". We were reborn in Baptism through the fount of Baptism as through a second birth and we now live our Christian life -always as a part of this Church. When faced with the magnitude of our current crisis our proper response should be to "put out into the deep" by working for her authentic reform and healing. May God give us courage and strength to do so.

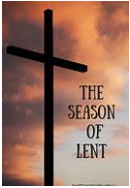
