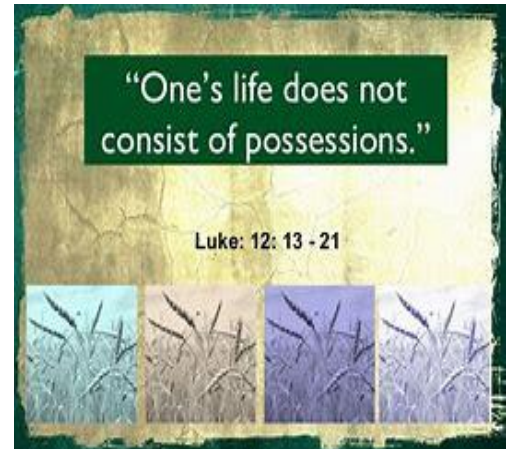

## PASTORS NOTES

### True Riches

Pope Francis, commenting on the words of the evangelist Luke, lists what he calls the 'Four Woes': 'Woe to the rich, Woe to the self-satisfied, Woe to those who laugh now, Woe to you when all speak well of you'.

The pope reminded us what's bad is not riches or a comfortable lifestyle but 'the attachment to riches' which becomes idolatry.

There are three slippery steps that lead us to sin in our attitude toward material things.

1. The attachment to riches, "because I need nothing;" Self-sufficiency with no room for God in our lives.

2. Vanity (pride)—That all must speak well of me, making me feel important, making too much of a fuss over me and when I am convinced that no matter what anyone else says, I am in the right.

3. Woe to you who laugh now - Those who laugh at the misfortunes of others and show no concern for them: "They got what they deserved."

The rich man in the parable only has things, not a life worth living. No friends with whom he can share his good fortune, no family to be his heirs. He is a sad, lonely, self-centered person. He fails to remember that one day he will die and then his riches will go to someone else and he will be forgotten.

May God give us the grace to be strong in times of need and grateful in times of prosperity and never take pleasure in the sufferings of others, even our enemies.
